Entry: Accepted the Saturday fair opens from 10am-2pm

Each exhibitor is limited to one entry per class. Exhibits removed before 9:00 PM on the final Saturday of the fair will forfeit premiums. Best of Sections awarded Rosettes only. Best of Section to compete for Best of Show - \$2.00 premium and Rosette. Judging will be on Sunday.

Judging Notes: (Preference will be given as follows)

1. Hay – completely cured, weed free
2. Potatoes – unwashed
3. Beets – tops trimmed to 1”-2”
4. Cucumbers, Pickles – stems on
5. Green Tomatoes – stems on
6. Ripe Tomatoes – stems off
7. Onions – roots trimmed, skins intact, stems dry
8. Carrots – tops trimmed close
9. Cabbage – ½”-1” stems, 2-4 wrapper leaves
10. Corn—husked and covered
11. Where multiple items are required, uniformity will be stressed

Section A - Displays

1. Farm Hay – 5 lbs from any 3 hay classes (classes 6-9)
2. Market Basket – 1 each from any 8 vegetable or fruit classes, except half of class requirements of classes 29-31. Items in basket may not be moved during judging
3. Truck Garden – Class requirements of any 8 classes in Section C

Section B – Field Crops

4. Corn – 3 stalks, roots intact
5. Mixed Hay (50% grass/50% legume) – 8 inch flake
6. Alfalfa Hay – 8 inch flake
7. Clover Hay – 8 inch flake
8. Grass Hay – 8 inch flake
9. Hay, Other – 8 inch flake
10. Small Grains – 1 quart in a Ziploc freezer bag
