ENTRIES are taken the Saturday fair starts from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM

The Art Department of the Marshall County Fair has been established specifically for local amateur and hobby-type artists, who as a rule, do not often get the opportunity to exhibit their work to the public, or for judging.

The Marshall County Fair Art Department is open to all area artists, both amateur and professional. We request, however, that all established or professional artists who submit entries please do so in the Professional category, as to be judged with work of equal merit. Judging is 9:00 AM on Sunday.

### Rules:

1. Entries may be of any artistic medium: oils acrylics, pastels, charcoal, pencil, etc.
2. All entries shall be submitted for exhibition in a sturdy frame or photo matting, securely wired on back for hanging. Framing and wiring are the responsibility of the exhibitor. Entries not conforming to this rule will not be accepted.
3. All pencil, charcoal, pastel, and non-permanent mediums shall be framed under glass by the exhibitor. Entries in these categories not covered with glass will not be accepted.
4. Works submitted should have been completed within the last year and not previously exhibited at the Marshall County Fair.
5. All decisions of the judge are final.
6. If enough entries permit, each section will be divided into one or more of the following classes:
  1. Portraits
  2. Landscapes
  3. Still-Life
  4. Animals
  5. Abstract
  6. Miscellaneous
7. Only one entry per class will be accepted by, with a total of no more than five entries per exhibitor.
8. Entries will be accepted on the designated date and times only unless prior arrangements have been made with the Department Superintendents.
9. A Best in Show award will be presented in each the Adult and Children categories.
10. The Marshall County Fair reserves the right to reject any entry deemed objectionable or in bad taste, due to the family-oriented nature of this event.
