

## 4H/FFA HORSE & PONY SHOW

Wednesday of fair

The purpose of West Virginia 4H equine activities is to develop youths through the horse project. Properly organized and conducted, horse shows can provide competition as a stimulus for learning, achieving, and developing good sportsmanship.

### Rules

1. All contestants **MUST** wear a helmet when riding.
2. Dress Code: White long-sleeve shirt, black pants, black tie or bolo, hat and boots

### Requirements:

1. Proof of 5-way vaccination and a Negative Coggins Test (within 12 months). **THIS MUST BE PRESENTED AT THE EXHIBITOR'S GATE DURING VET CHECK.**
2. All 4H/FFA Horse Project members must show in Fitting & Showmanship according to their year in the 4H/FFA Horse Project. In addition, members must choose one class to ride in according to their division (Western, English or Contest). This will meet the requirements for the 4H Score Sheet.
3. Riding is **OPTIONAL** for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year exhibitors.
4. After meeting class requirements for the 4H score sheet, members may enter any additional pre-registered classes.

The classes will run according to the West Virginia 4H Horse and Pony Show Rule Book. Participants will be responsible for understanding and complying with the rules.

Rule books are available at the Marshall County Extension Office.
