

SECTION C1: SHEEP AND WOOL LEADLINE

Wednesday of the fair at 3:00 PM (prior to Open Class Sheep Show)

The objectives of this class are to present a class of ewes in a most attractive manner and to give spectators an opportunity to see the best of the Sheep Industry.

Rules:

1. Competition is open to any person, male or female, of any age. Competition will be divided into the following divisions:
WOMEN Class 1 (ages 6 and under) MEN Class 4 (ages 6 and under)
 Class 2 (ages 7-14) Class 5 (ages 7-14)
 Class 3 (ages 15 and over) Class 6 (ages 15 and over)
2. Entrant's outfit must be made of at least 50% wool and must be appropriate, attractive, and lend elegance to the class. Contestants need not make the outfit. Outfits worn previously in leadline competition will not be permitted.
3. Sheep must be ewes or ewe lambs. Ewes need not be registered, but must be conditioned, fitted, and trained to show with halter. Ewes must have a scrapies tag.
4. A commentary which must include the name, address, county, and age of the entrant, a description of the outfit to be worn, activities in which the entrant participates, and the age, breed, and owner of the sheep to be used should be submitted to Jean Dougherty by the Monday of fair week. All contestants should be at the Halley Hubbs Arena ready to show at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the competition.
5. **Please specify leadline on your entry form—you must complete separate entry forms and pay the designated fees, if entering both leadline and open class sheep categories.**
