1. Jr. Heifer calf, born between 2/28/14 and 5/1/14
2. Intermediate Heifer calf, born between 11/30/13 and 3/11/14
3. Sr. Heifer calf, born between 8/31/13 and 12/1/13
4. Summer Yearling, born between 5/31/13 and 9/1/13
5. Junior Yearling Heifer, born between 2/28/13 and 6/1/13
6. Intermediate Yearling Heifer, born between 11/30/12 and 3/1/13
7. Senior Yearling Heifer, born between 8/31/12 and 12/1/12
8. *Junior Champion Female (registered), winners of Classes 1-7.
 - i. Youth
 - ii. Open
9. *Reserve Junior Champion Female, Class 8 minus the Champion, including 2nd place from Champion's original class.
10. Junior Best Three Females, animal's eligible for classes 1-7, all bred and owned by exhibitor. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry.
11. *Junior Two-year-old (Never Freshened), born between 2/28/12 and 9/1/12
12. *Senior Two-year-old (Never Freshened), born between 8/31/11 and 3/1/12
13. *Junior Two-year-old (Milking), born between 2/28/12 and 9/1/12
14. *Senior Two-year-old (Milking), born between 2/28/12 and 3/1/12
15. Three-year-old, born between 8/31/10 and 9/1/11
16. Four-year-old, born between 8/31/09 and 9/1/10
17. Aged Cow, five years or older, born before 9/1/09
18. Dry Cow, three years and older, born before 8/31/10 (Dry dates must be reported when animals are checked into the show and this date may be forwarded to the respective breed association).
19. *Senior Champion Female (registered), winners of Classes 11-18
 - A. Youth
 - B. Open
20. *Reserve Senior Champion Female, Class 8 minus the Champion, including 2nd place from Champion's original class.
21. *Grand Champion Female, winner of classes 8 and 19.
 - A. Youth
 - B. Open
22. Reserve Champion Female, winners of classes 8,9,19, and 20, minus Grand Champion.
 - A. Youth
 - B. Open
23. Dam-Daughter, consisting of two females, owned and shown by one exhibitor, one being the daughter of the other.
24. Produce-of-Dam, consisting of two females, any age, the produce of one cow. The dam must be named. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry from the same dam.
25. Dairy Herd, to consist of three cows over 2 years, having all calved at least once to be owned by exhibitor. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry.
26. Best Three Females, any age, all bred and owned by exhibitor. Each exhibitor is limited to one entry
27. Supreme Champion All Breeds
28. Jr. Bull calf, born between 2/28/14 and 5/1/14
29. Intermediate Bull calf, born between 11/30/13 and 3/11/14
30. Sr. Bull Calf, born between 8/31/13 and 12/1/13
31. Grand Champion Bull
32. Reserve Champion Bull
