- Livestock will be judged in 4-H classes. They may also be judged in open class competition with the exception of Market Steer, Market Lambs, and Market Hogs. These may be shown in 4-H classes only.
- Animals entered individually cannot be combined and entered as pen of three or flock. A pen of three or flock cannot be entered individually. A flock consists of five or more animals entered as one entry.
- All open class sheep must be shown with scrapies tags.
- All market lambs must have scrapies tags.
- All 4-H livestock will receive a blue, red, or white ribbon. The amount of premium to be paid is decided according to the color of ribbon received, specified below for each section, other than Showmanship.
